PF YOUTH GROUP SUMMER 2017 PILGRIMAGE – RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES

Rule #1: EVERYTHING REQUIRES FULL PARTICIPATION. All programs and activities are constructed carefully, and much preparation has gone into the planning. The flow of our time together has been evaluated carefully as well. Enough time for all activities is given, including sleep time. This means that skipping out, leaving the premises, sneaking out at night, etc., are violations of this rule. When there is a violation of Rule No. 1, the procedure is as follows:

PROCEDURE:

1. An Adult Advisor or Rev. Kev will talk one-on one with the person who violated the rule.
2. If the violation occurs again, two adults (and Adult Advisor and Rev. Kevin) will talk with the offending youth.
3. If the violation occurs a third time, Rev. Kevin will inform the parents of the offending youth. A meeting will be convened with the offending youth, his or her parents, and Rev. Kevin upon returning home.

Rule #2: WE MAKE OUR OWN MUSIC. Musical instruments are welcomed; sensitivity to those around you is encouraged. Quiet use of personal ipods when falling asleep is permissible. Personal ipods are not to be used at any other time as they inhibit the building and growing of relationships with one another. There will be times when listening to music as a group is appropriate.

PROCEDURE:

When there is a violation of Rule No. 2, the procedure is the same as Rule No. 1.

Rule #3: NO WEAPONS!!! (Guns, knives, etc.) Absolutely, positively, emphatically...no weapons!

PROCEDURE:

This written and verbal explanation constitutes the first and second warnings. If there is a violation of this rule, Rev. Kevin will immediately inform the parents of the offending youth. A meeting will be convened with the offending youth, his or her parents, and Rev. Kev upon returning home.

Rule #4: NO DRUGS!!! NO ALCOHOL!!! NO SMOKING OR TOBACCO RELATED PRODUCTS!!! (cigars, cigarettes, chew, pot, etc.). Absolutely, positively, emphatically...no drugs! No alcohol! No tobacco related products!

PROCEDURE:

This written and verbal explanation constitutes the first and second warnings. If there is a violation of this rule, Rev. Kevin will immediately inform the parents of the offending youth. A meeting will be convened with the offending youth, his or her parents, and Rev. Kev upon returning home.

Rule #5: NO SEX. Absolutely, positively, emphatically...NO SEX! Any kind of sexual activity is a violation of this rule.

PROCEDURE:

This written and verbal explanation constitutes the first and second warning. If there is a violation of this rule, Rev. Kev will immediately inform the parents of the offending youth. A meeting will be convened with the offending youth, his or her parents, and Rev. Kevin upon returning home. Behavior that is suggestive of sexual activity, i.e., excessive public displays of affection and so forth, may be subject to evaluation by the adult leaders and procedures outlined in Rules No. 1 and 2 will be followed.
